### WHO MUST COMPLY?

- Payers: Per CCR section 1101-3, Rule 16-8-1, all payers (except self-insured employers) must accept e-bills.
- Providers Including SelectNet Participants: Any provider submitting 25+ workers' comp bills per month must bill electronically starting January 1, 2026.

### HOW IT WORKS:

When providers submit through CiC:

- Payers send an acknowledgment of receipt within 2 business days
- Payers send Electronic Remittance Advice (ERA) within 30 days
- Duplicate paper bills are prohibited
